

Stormwater BMP Courses Now Available

The Office of Water Programs at Sacramento State University is now offering distance learning courses based on the California Stormwater Quality Association's (CASQA) Stormwater Best Management Practice (BMP) Handbooks. These courses are designed to provide continuing education for professional engineers, employees of municipal agencies, regulatory agencies, developers, construction companies, and others to increase their knowledge of stormwater best management practices. CASQA BMP online courses have been approved as operator training courses by the California Water Environment Association (CWEA), and by operator certification boards in 24 states so far.

Enrollment in each course includes a study guide on CD-ROM, with reading assignments, practice quizzes, and case studies based on the material presented in each handbook. You will also receive an ID number and password, and instructions on how to access the final exam on the internet. Two Continuing Education Units (CEUs) will be awarded for completing each course. **Please Note:** CEUs earned for these courses may not apply to specific drinking water and wastewater operator training programs, please check with your state certification office.

WAT 614A NEW DEVELOPMENT AND REDEVELOPMENT

This course provides general guidance for selecting and implementing BMPs to reduce pollutants in runoff in newly developed areas and redeveloped areas to waters of the state. Topics covered include planning for new development and redevelopment, site and facility design for water quality protection, source control BMPs, treatment control BMPs, and long-term maintenance of BMPs.

WAT 614B CONSTRUCTION

This course provides guidance on developing and implementing Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plans (SWPPPs) that document the selection and implementation of BMPs for particular types of construction projects. Topics covered include site requirements; erosion and sediment control BMPs; and non-stormwater management and material management BMPs.

WAT 614C MUNICIPAL

This course provides general guidance for selecting and implementing BMPs to reduce pollutants in runoff from municipal operations to waters of the state. Topics covered include regulatory requirements, pollution prevention planning, source control BMPs, treatment control BMPs, and long-term maintenance of BMPs.
